

Statement of Brook Hiddink: Prior E-Commerce Stores

I, **Brook Hiddink**, founder of High Ticket (BERH Stores & Consulting Inc. - FZCO), make this statement to substantiate a claim used in High Ticket's advertising: that before I found the business model High Ticket teaches, I built thirteen online stores that failed. The exhibit below is an unaltered copy of the record described.

1. Before I launched my first high-ticket store, I personally set up and operated **thirteen (13)** online dropshipping stores. My Shopify account lists exactly **13 inactive stores** and 1 active store (Exhibit A).
2. Every one of these stores was owned and operated by me. No other person owned or operated them.
3. These stores generally sold low-cost products sourced from suppliers in China and shipped directly to customers.
4. None of the thirteen stores became a profitable business. Each one was closed or abandoned, which is why they are inactive.
5. The thirteen stores are separate from the high-ticket store I later built, whose revenue is documented in my separate statements.
6. Supported wording: **"I built thirteen stores and all of them failed", "thirteen failed stores before this one worked"**.
